Hope you are well. We're well but it's difficult to be so far apart for so long. We know we're working together to serve the same good, loving, all-powerful God!

At this Easter time we're running a Youth Camp in Koundoul for the children of *La Bergerie* School. This gives each child the opportunity to have an intense time of prayer, worship and Biblical teaching in a supportive environment, to help them grow in their relationship with Jesus. We're also running workshops on how to play the guitar/drums, leather working & sewing, first aid and IT.

Celestin is busy directing the team from the church, *La Bergerie Evangelique des Nations* to organise and run the camp. 60 children came on the first day, and more are likely to arrive during the week. The theme is, "Let no-one despise your youth and go with the strength you have." We are expecting miracles as God works in the lives of all those involved! The camp comes after running a seminar in the church entitled, 'Only the cross of Golgotha!'

Margaret is officially half-way through her Return to Nursing course. Long days mean getting up at 05:30 to catch the bus to the community hospital placement, working an 11.5 hour shift, and arriving back at Mum's house at 21:30. It's tiring but going well; the 'mock' maths test wasn't so bad as expected! Praise God!

We're hoping Celestin will be able to apply for a UK visa, to visit for a couple of months during the summer. This means having to raise enough support/funds for the journey, provide the right documents and evidence and make a long trip to the application centre.

financially. Thank you especially to those who helped with paying the teachers' salaries. It is an ongoing challenge that gets harder during the school year as money runs out.
